ADMISSION PHILOSOPHY AND INSTRUCTIONS

Heidelberg College is a diverse community of learners. Applicants come from a variety of backgrounds and with differing interests. The Admission Committee seeks talented and motivated students who will benefit from and contribute to the college experience. Our admission process is highly personalized and we consider the “whole person” as we identify students who would be a good match for Heidelberg. We encourage all candidates for admission to submit their applications after the completion of their junior year of high school. Notifications are generally made within two weeks. *Please note, all information submitted on this form and through the admission process will be kept confidential.*

FRESHMAN APPLICANTS

- Candidates for admission are considered on the basis of academic qualities, personal talents and interests.
- The following are recommended for a minimum preparation:
 - ▶ **English:** 4 years
 - ▶ **Social Studies:** 3 years
 - ▶ **Mathematics:** 3 years
 - ▶ **Natural Sciences:** 3 years
 - ▶ **Academic Electives:** Applicants should have a strong college preparatory foundation. Suggested electives would include, but should not be limited to, two years of another language and a course in computer science.
- Applicants are evaluated by the types of courses selected and the nature of the high school.
- The Admission Committee is interested in the activities in which the applicant has participated during high school. Consideration is given for talent or involvement in sports, musical groups and other organizations.
- Students interested in merit scholarships are urged to apply early in their senior year.
- Freshman applicants should submit:
 - ▶ Completed Application for Admission
 - ▶ Official high school transcript including ACT or SAT scores
 - ▶ \$25.00 application fee

TRANSFER APPLICANTS

- Students who wish to transfer to Heidelberg College should apply by December 1 for the Spring Semester and by August 1 for the Fall Semester.
- A minimum cumulative grade point average of 2.0 (A=4.0 scale) is required for admission from another college or university. Courses with a grade of “C” or better are eligible for transfer consideration. A credit evaluation will be mailed separately.
- Transfer applicants should submit:
 - ▶ Completed Application for Admission
 - ▶ Official transcripts from all colleges attended
 - ▶ Official final high school transcript including ACT or SAT scores
 - ▶ Personnel Dean’s Data Form from last college attended
 - ▶ \$25.00 application fee
